Procedures Concerning Requests from Parents to Educate Their Child at Home

The Montville Board of Education recognizes the right of parents to educate their children at home. Parents must file with the Superintendent of Schools, a Notice of Intent from which provides basic information about the program to be provided for their child. A Notice of Intent must be filed annually.

The Board believes that formal education in public schools is highly beneficial both for the child and for society.

Home schooling is viewed by the Montville Board of Education as full time and therefore home schooled students are not eligible for school offerings for activities.
