Pupils and Law Enforcement Officials

Properly identified representatives of law enforcement agencies and of the courts shall be given every reasonable assistance in carrying out their functions on school grounds, for it is a primary responsibility of every teacher and citizen to help promote justice and the welfare of the community. However, in carrying out such functions, it is understood that:

1. No pupil shall be interviewed until parents are contacted and permission is granted for the interview.
2. Agents of the police and courts shall receive permission from the principal or his/her deputy before interviewing.
3. A representative of the school shall be present during such interviews "in loco parentis" in the absence of parents or other such persons to be designated by the parents.
