School Safety and Security

The Board of Education directs the superintendent to establish a district-wide Committee on School Safety and Security. The committee may include: the Montville Police Department Detective/School liaison (co-chair), high school principal (or designate), middle school principal (or designate), alternative high school principal (or designate), three (3) elementary principals (or designates), the Fire Marshall (or designate), the transportation coordinator, a parent representative, and a Montville High School student (as needed). The superintendent will also appoint replacements.

The committee will meet three times per year in September, January, and May and other times as necessary. The committee will review issues related to school safety and security and advocate improvements. The committee will consult with experts and resource persons as necessary. The committee will report to the superintendent who will annually present the committee's work and recommendations to the Board of Education.

It is recommended that the committee give attention to matters such as routine issues of safety, traffic on and around school grounds, emergency procedures, contingency planning, and other items referred by the superintendent and/or the Board of Education.
