Student Records: Office of the Child Advocate

It is the policy of the Montville Board of Education to recognize the State of Connecticut Office of the Child Advocate as legally constituted and its authorization under PA 95-242 to represent a child, with parental consent, in any state proceeding. Accordingly, the Montville Board of Education stipulates that all rules, policies, and procedures governing student records are amended to provide the Office of the Child Advocate access to all school records, given parental/custodial consent, necessary to carry out advocate responsibilities. Further, it is the policy of the Montville Board of Education to give the Office of the Child Advocate access to current school health records and a child's academic records obtainable by his non-custodial parent.
