Student Pregnancy

Students who become pregnant remain entitled to all school privileges. Moreover, Connecticut education regulations provide that students who are pregnant are eligible for special education services. Given the student's privacy interests, the decision whether or not to notify the school administration of pregnancy remains with the student. If her pregnancy affects her educational progress, the student should notify the school administration or her guidance counselor so that a planning and placement team can be convened to determine what, if any, special arrangements should be made.
