Superintendent of Schools

The Board of Education will elect and fix the term of office and the salary of the Superintendent who serves as the chief executive officer of the Board and has authority and responsibility for the supervision of the school system.

At the request of the Superintendent, the Board shall provide a written contract of employment which includes salary, benefits and terms of office of the Superintendent.

Each year, the Board will evaluate the Superintendent in accordance with guidelines and criteria mutually determined and agreed upon by both the Board and the Superintendent.
