

## **Business/Non-Instructional Operations**

### **Transfer of Funds Between Categories; Amendments**

In accordance with Section 10-222 of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Board of Education shall prepare an itemized estimate of its budget each year for submission to the fiscal authority for review and appropriation. Line items in such budget estimate shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Salaries
2. Employee Benefits
3. Purchased Services
4. Tuition
5. Supplies
6. Property
7. Other

Following the annual appropriation, the Board of Education shall meet and revise such itemized estimate, if necessary, and adopt a final appropriated budget for the year. Line items in the budget may be allocated more specifically by the Superintendent or his/her designee in the development, administration and monitoring of the budget.

The Superintendent and/or his/her designee shall be responsible for administering and monitoring the budget through the course of the year. The Superintendent or his/her designee shall maintain a system of appropriate expenditures and encumbrance accounting that is organized to conform with the requirements for state and Federal Accounting Reports. A quarterly budget report shall be prepared in the same format as the annual budget showing for each line item the appropriated budget amount, expenditures to date (to include encumbered and expended amounts), projected expenditures, difference between the projected expenditures and the appropriation, and general comments indicating the reasons for the difference as discussed.

Based on expenditures and budget projections, with such budget reports the Superintendent shall recommend to the Board of Education transfers from one line item (as set forth above) to another as needed.

The Superintendent is authorized to make such transfers as necessary if the urgent need for the transfer prevents the Board of Education from meeting in a timely fashion to consider the transfer, provided that such transfers by the Superintendent shall not exceed five percent (5%) of the annual budget. Transfers made in such instances shall be announced at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Education, and transfers subsequently ratified by the Board at such meeting shall not be counted in the limitation on the authority of the Superintendent to make transfers.

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### **Transfer of Funds between Categories; Amendments (continued)**

The Board of Education shall provide a written explanation of the emergency transfer to the town's legislative body or, if the legislative body is a town meeting, to the Board of Selectman.

The Board of Education shall not expend more than the amount of the appropriation and the money received from other sources for school purposes. If any occasion arises whereby additional funds are needed by the Board of Education, the Chairperson of the Board shall notify the Board of Selectpersons/Town Council and submit a request for such necessary additional funds. No additional funds shall be expended until such supplemental appropriation is granted and no supplemental expenditures shall be made in excess of those so authorized.

The Superintendent shall submit to the Board an annual report covering the preceding school year not later than the October meeting of the Board.
