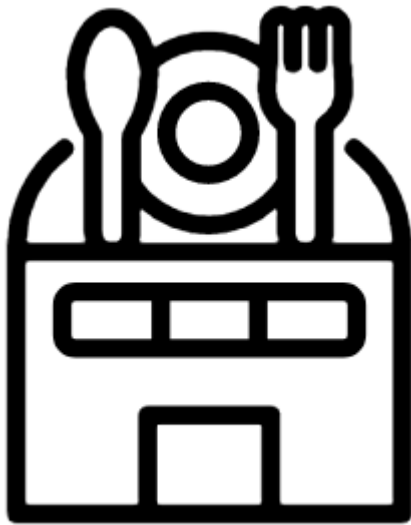

## Our First Week of School

## School Meals

## Next Week's Schedule

We will begin full-day classes on Monday.

Cohort 1 will attend classes on Monday and Tuesday. For Tyl and MHS students Monday is an A day; Tuesday is a B day.

Cohort 2 will attend classes on Thursday and Friday. **We will not hold our scheduled PD half day on Friday. Friday will be a full day of school for students.** For Tyl and MHS students Thursday is an A day; Friday is a B day.

Wednesday is a distance learning day for all students. For Tyl and MHS students Wednesday is a B day.

We will take attendance for each cohort on their distance learning days. Students are expected to log into their electronic classrooms as instructed by their classroom teachers.

We will also take daily attendance for our fully remote learners. Every student is expected to attend school every day.

A student who has been tested and is awaiting results should not come to school even if they are asymptomatic.



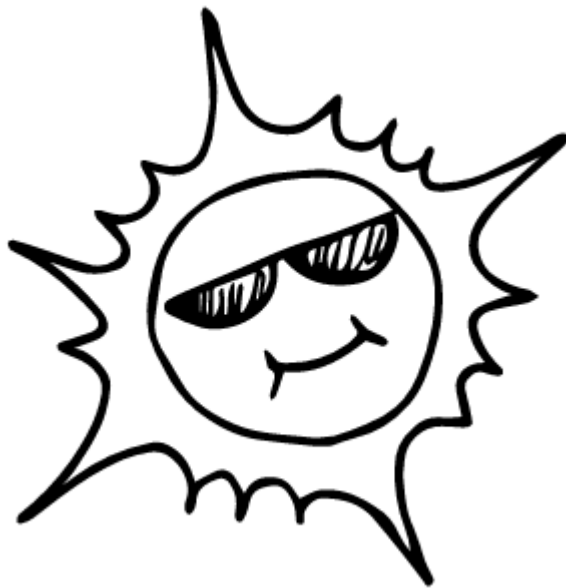
## Student Devices
